

"The author of the book, Georgia Hunter, based the book on the extensive research she did of her family's history. She maintains a blog describing her research. There is a great deal of very interesting background information from her research at the bottom of her blog page (<u>at this link</u>).

"I found this book interesting because of my own family's history. Most of my family died in the holocaust but didn't know their stories. This book helped me to understand what it must have been like for the members of my family that didn't make it out.

"I would add that there will be a Hulu movie about the book ---- filming is beginning this Fall, and I think it is scheduled for release in 2023."

Rosh Hashanah Centerpieces: Toilet Paper Roll Apples

Rosh Hashanah is a few weeks away. Here is an easy and fabulous apple craft that can be used as centerpieces or decoration. You can make it with your child or grandchild as a fun activity.

Materials needed:

Red construction paper

Green construction paper

Scissors

Tape

Empty Toilet Paper Roll

Directions:

1. Cut strips of red construction paper (strips should be just a bit longer than the toilet paper roll)

2. Tape top and bottom of the strips to the inside of the toilet paper roll.

3. Cut out a green leaf and a green stem.

4. Tape them on the inside of the toilet paper roll.

5. Display.
